



How to Replace a Button

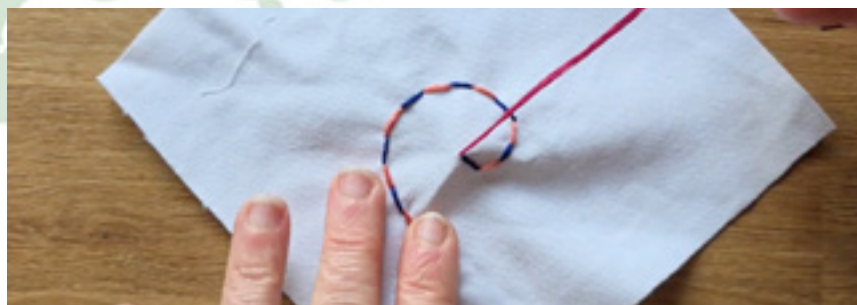

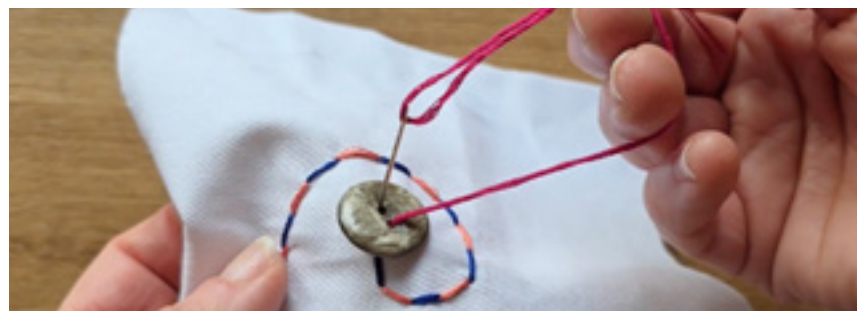

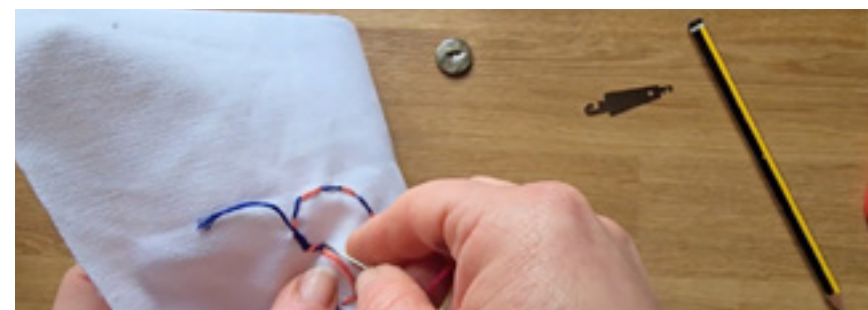
Next, pull the needle and thread through to the front.
But make sure you don't pull it all the way, even knots can come through with enough force!

Now push the needle through the other hole and push to the back as shown. Repeat this at least two more times* to secure. Repeat at least 3-4 times on clothing fastenings - or it won't be strong enough.

Starting from the back of the fabric, push the needle through, this will be the centre of where your button will be.
(The fabric in this photo, already has stitching on it)

Next push your needle through one of the button holes, as shown (in the photo). Then let it drop onto the fabric.

Once the threads are securely knotted, you can cut off the excess

Well done, you can now sew & repair buttons!
